• P. James reports that due to COVID, most people are going to continue to telecommute, that is the priority.

- CRIT reviews the plans w the OC Health Authority then recommends or not with the strategic advisory group in regards to who can return to work and when. Research staff and graduate students are back on campus and undergraduates will be remote.
- The spike in COVID cases has changed the game on timeline for staff to return. The Working Well website has a leader guide and symptom checklist.
- Vacation accruals can be accrued over the max but as of Jan 1st, you can't accrue any more until you go below the max.
- Telecommute agreements do we need to keep those up to date? Whatever agreement you have in place has shifted to whatever the governor has stated as the stay at home orders.
- Working Well Tool Kit has a new Employee Guide
- Working on some welcome back kits

Statement of Subject: Employee Engagement and Wellness

- D. Hall reported on the Virtual Staff Service Awards gifts have been ordered and we are looking into mailing options. We are starting video production in the next 2 weeks with Thank You and Appreciation messages. People can self check their employment credit in UC Path. Honorees will submit images and quotes. Credits are based on the fiscal year as of June 30th. Vacation accruals got switched over to Path.

- Wellbeing and Learning environment training both virtual and physical. For employees and faculty and impacting students. PDF's to come.
- Potential drive-through flu shot clinic coming in Fall/late September.
- UC Walks is being delayed and will be combined with the Step-Up and Anti-Cancer Challenges.
- Engagement Survey is still happening early Fall to a 25% random subset of our staff.
